Message from Pete:

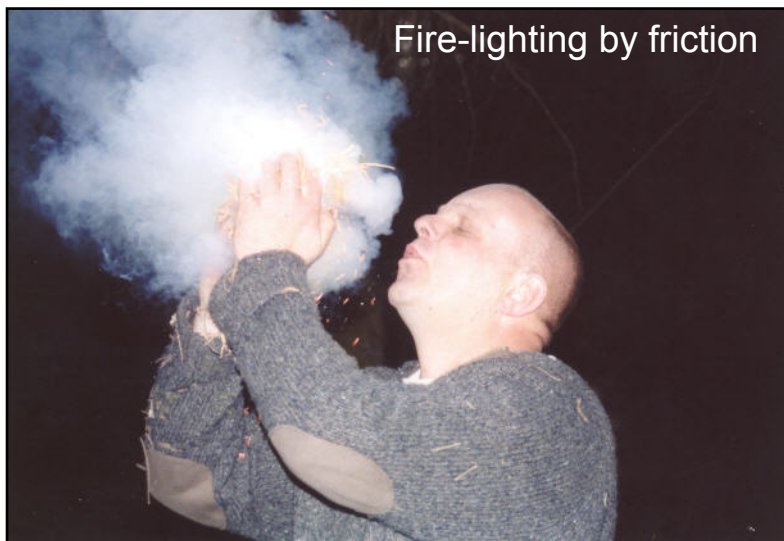
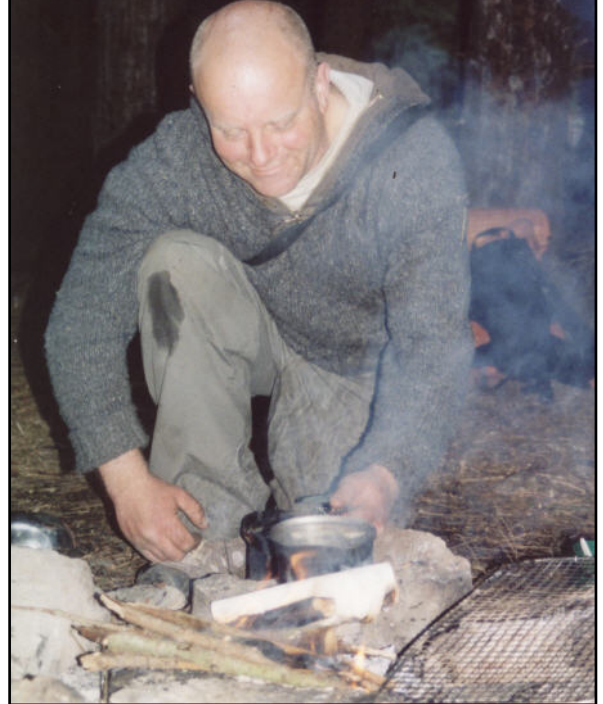
